

# Business and farm HW Collection Program

Businesses and farmers can dispose of their hazardous waste conveniently and cost effectively through the Northwest Cleansweep Business and Agriculture Collection Program at the Spooner Hazardous Waste Storage Site or the Northwest Mobile Collection Events.

Common hazardous wastes that are accepted include:

- Antifreeze
- Asbestos
- Corrosives
- Insecticides
- Pesticides
- Cleaning Solvents
- Fluorescent tubes
- Solvent-based Adhesives, Glues
- Mercury Products
- Degreasers
- Automotive Fluids
- Oil-based Paints\*
- Oil Filters
- Ballasts

\* Latex paints are non-hazardous and can be disposed of in your regular trash by evaporating/hardening the liquid (cat litter, sawdust, absorbent). Leave the top off so your garbage hauler knows that it is in fact dried. If you are having a problem disposing of latex paint this way, contact your garbage hauler.

Often, it is not easy for businesses and farms that generate small quantities of hazardous waste to find low cost, simple and convenient means for disposal. Northwest Cleansweep's Ag./business program evolved to serve the very small quantity generator (VSQG) with these problems. In 1996 Northwest Cleansweep received the Governor's Award for Excellence in Hazardous Waste Reduction for designing and implementing the innovative system to collect, process and ship hazardous wastes.
