

The Northwest Cleansweep hazardous waste “milk run” program, which is designed to accept hazardous wastes from municipalities, businesses and schools from our ten-county region, is once again offering hazardous waste collections this fall. The “milk run” program had a very successful spring 2003 collection, and anticipates the same this fall.

This year’s fall collection will be taking place soon and Northwest Cleansweep invites your participation. Items accepted this fall are fluorescent bulbs, computers, oil-based paint, solvents or adhesives, antifreeze, aerosols, batteries, poison solids, pesticides (solid or liquid), ballasts, mercury, and other items considered hazardous. The Northwest Cleansweep Milk Run Program invites any municipality, school or business wishing to participate in the fall 2003 collection to call and schedule a pick-up. Pre-registration is required and should be done soon to assure a spot in this year’s collection. Registrations will be accepted until October 3<sup>rd</sup>.
